

General Information for Youth in Action 2012

For youth leaders and volunteers

We will be staying at St. John's in the Parish Hall and Youth House. Sleeping quarters will be classrooms and side rooms separated into girls and boys areas.

As far as meals and other details go....

Friday night we will serve pizza. Saturday breakfast will be served and after that, the teens will need to pack their sack lunches for the worksite. All the lunch supplies will be provided. They will also need to bring their shower supplies and a change of clothes to the worksite so we can go straight from there to our shower place. (St. John's has 2 showers, so *adults* can shower if needed on site. We ask that all teens shower on Saturday afternoon at the shower place only.) Dinner will be served after we return from showers. Sunday morning breakfast will be served and the teens can eat and then pack up and begin the cleanup process. We will all attend the 9am service and then head home. Due to liability concerns, only adult volunteers or staff may transport teens to Council and the work site. Any teen driving their own car to the event must park their car until Sunday.

4pm – Leave worksite and head to showers
6pm – Dinner
7pm – ***Inflatable Madness!***
11pm – Worship and music
12am – Lights out

7am – Breakfast and pack up
9am – Attend service at St. John's
10am – Clean up and head home
