

Packing List for Youth in Action 2012

- Sleeping bag / cot / mattress (we are sleeping on the floor, so get something comfy)
- Bedding
- Pillow
- Towel
- Toiletries
- Comfortable clothes for play and work*
- Appropriate work shoes**
- A backpack to transport shower supplies and clothes to the shower area
- Clothes for church on Sunday (no need to dress up)
- Work or gardening gloves
- A great attitude for service and play
- Your teddy bear or woobie (if needed)

* We will be working the Good Samaritan Center of the Rio Grande Valley on any special projects they will have for us. Just bring appropriate clothing that will both protect you from brushy areas and that you don't mind getting dirty.

** Closed toed shoes are a must for this work. No flip flops or sandals at the work site, please.

Please keep in mind that due to liability concerns, if you drive your own vehicle to Youth in Action it must remain parked until you return home on Sunday. This is a lock in and no youth members may leave the event until it is over on Sunday. Written parent permission is required for youth group members to leave the event before it is over. Transportation to Council and the worksite will be provided by adult volunteers.
