



Youth in Action is celebrating its tenth year of service, February 22 - 24! Like Diocesan Council, Youth in Action is a time of reunion, renewal, and building community for youth, reaching out in love, as the hands and feet of Jesus.

Youth in Action 2019 has two main service projects: outdoor painting and gardening at **The Comfort Home**, a nonprofit providing end-of-life care, and helping to sort donated

food at **Emily's Meals**, which serves 50 meals a day to people living without shelter.

Who should attend: all students in 6th through 12th grade!

REMEMBER: Each church must provide adult chaperones for the youth from their congregation, that can be present at Youth in Action the entire weekend (cannot be participating in Council). All chaperones must have completed the Safeguarding God's Children course in the Diocese of West Texas, or Diocese of Texas, in the last five years. [Ratio of youth per sponsor = 5:1]
